





TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE: COLLEGE OF NURSING

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's and pursue a major in the College of Nursing, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer to degree programs within the College of Nursing. This list does not include every technical college course available for transfer to USC. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors.* You should be aware that courses must be passed with a *grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. *You must have a GPA of 2.75 and earned a "C" or higher in each science course attempted to be considered for admission.* Please review admissions requirements at www.sc.edu/admissions.

Technical College Courses

College of Nursing Course Requirements

Humanities:

- 1) ENG 101 and 102
- 2) HIS 101, 102, 108, 110, 115, 201, or 202
- 3) ART 101, 107, 108; MUS 105; THE 101, 105; SPC 205

Analytical Reasoning:

MAT 120 or MAT 130

Social Sciences:

Choose one of the following approved sequences:

- a. PSY 201 and 203
- b. SOC 101 and 220

Laboratory Sciences:

All of the following are required:

- 1) CHM 105
- 2) BIO 210
- 3) BIO 211
- 4) BIO 225

Electives:

Note: Students transferring to USC who have not successfully complete two foreign language courses must take the University's placement exam and complete foreign languages as required by the exam results. (FRE 101, 102 and SPA 101, 102 are acceptable).

Major Courses:

To be determined upon evaluation.

Humanities (12 hours):

- 1) ENGL 101 and 102 (6 hours)
- 2) One HIST course (3 hours)
- 3) One Fine Arts (3 hours)

Analytical Reasoning (3 hours):

STAT 201 or MATH 122 (3 hours)

Social Sciences (6 hours):

Both courses must be in the same discipline and include coverage of life span:

- a. PSYC 101 and 420 (6 hours)
- b. SOCY 101 and 305 (6 hours)

Laboratory Sciences (16 hours):

All of the following are required:

- 1) CHEM 102 (4 hours)
- 2) BIO 243 and 243L (4 hours)
- 3) BIO 244 and 244L (4 hours)
- 4) BIO 250 and 250L (4 hours)

Electives (6 hours):

Note: Students must have the equivalent of two semesters of study in a foreign language and demonstrate proficiency on the University's placement examination.

Major Courses:

These courses have been approved for ADN/RN transfer students only.

^{*} Technical students must meet all requirements for admission to USC and must be accepted through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.
