



TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE: EXERCISE SCIENCE MAJOR

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's School of Public Health to *pursue a major the department of exercise science*, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer to degree programs within the School of Public Health. This list does not include every technical college course which is available for transfer to USC. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors.* You should be aware that courses must be passed with a *grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. *You must have a GPA of 2.75 to be considered for admission*. Course Equivalents

Foreign Language Courses:

FRE 101, 102 SPA 101, 102

(Students transferring to USC who have not sucessfully completed two foreign language courses must take the University's placement exam and complete foreign languages as required by the exam results).
